*** Wednesday 20th March 2024 – £95**

11am Troy Scott-Smith “Revitalising Vita – Sissinghurst – the future informed by the past” Head Gardener of Sissinghurst in Kent needs little introduction as he is world class garden writer, speaker and designer.

2pm Rob Evans, Pheasant Acre Plants – Summer flowering bulbs, corms, tubers and rhizomes.” Rob grows gold medal winning flowers – this talk will be on summer flowering species such as alstromeria and agapanthus to crocosmia, gladioli and dahlias.

11am Yaniv Korman “Digging, Drawing, Planting” – Reconstructing The Ancient Roman Gardens” Yaniv is **Tom Stuart-Smith Studio** Landscape Architect. He is also lead architect in the Casa Della Regina Carolina research of Ancient gardens in the Middle East, giving talks worldwide. This presentation will focus on new findings with excellent graphics that are a delight and relevance for all present day gardeners.

2pm Richard Bramley, Farmyard Nurseries – “A plantsman’s tour of New Zealand” Richard is well known for his Gardeners’ World “In the pink” collaboration with Sue Kent.
